(Japanese version) Technical Report of GSI Terms of Use

a. Using the Technical Report of the GSI

Public Data License (Version 1.0) (PDL1.0) applies mutatis mutandis to the information made available on the Technical Report of the GSI (hereinafter referred to as “the Technical Report”) unless otherwise stated. In this case, “Information made available on this website (hereinafter referred to as Content)” shall be replaced by “the Technical Report of the GSI”.

Please refer to “Important note on Public Data License (Version 1.0) for the use of the Technical Report of the GSI” for information on parts of PDL1.0 that differ from Content to Content, such as examples of source citations unique to Content and Content that is not subject to the Terms of Use.

In addition, “Geospatial Information Authority of Japan (GSI) Website Terms of Use” applies to the use of the Technical Report available on the GSI website.

“Important note on Public Data License (Version 1.0)” related to the use of the Technical Report of the GSI

The following are examples of the descriptions in PDL 1.0 that are individual regulations.

1) Source citation

- a. The user must cite the source when using the Technical Report. Please refer to the following example for how to cite the sources.

(Example of source citation)

Source: Technical Report of the Geospatial Information Authority of Japan (Technical Report number, Technical Report's title)

·When using the Technical Report in an academic paper or book, and so forth, you must give source citation in an appropriate manner set forth in the journal's rules.

- b. If the user has edited the Technical Report for use, you must include a statement expressing that the Technical Report has been edited, in addition to the abovementioned source citation. Please refer to the following examples. The edited information must not be published or used in such a way that it could be misconstrued as if it had been created by GSI.

(Example of citation when using edited Technical Report)

·Created by editing GSI Tiles (elevation tiles(Fundamental Geospatial Data Digital Elevation Model))

·Created by Company YY based on XX data (Technical Report of the Geospatial Information Authority of Japan)

2) No infringement of third party rights

- a. If a third party holds rights to a part of the Technical Report, said fact may be directly or indirectly stated or indicated through source citations, but in some cases the part of the Technical Report to which the third party holds the rights may not be clear or may not be explicitly stated. It is the responsibility of the user to confirm the rights pertaining to use of the Technical Report.
- b. The user must comply with the terms and conditions of the source provider for the Technical Report obtained through API (Application Programming Interface) links to external databases etc.

3) The Technical Report where the Terms of Use does not apply

If terms of use are set for software (programs), such terms of use shall apply.
